P.A. PETERSON CENTER FOR HEALTH HOSTS OPEN HOUSE CELEBRATING EXPANSION OF REHABILITATION UNIT

P.A. Peterson Center for Health, a program of Lutheran Social Services of Illinois (LSSI), is hosting an Open House on Wednesday, January 4, 2006, from 3:00 - 6:00 p.m. in celebration of the 10-bed expansion of its short-term rehabilitation unit. The ribbon-cutting ceremony will take place at 3:30 p.m. and refreshments will be served.

The Rev. Dr. Frederick Aigner, LSSI president, will participate in the celebration, as well as local dignitaries and officials from the Rockford Chamber of Commerce.

The P.A. Peterson Pathway Rehabilitation Unit consists of private rooms that are Medicare-certified for people who are recovering after a hospitalization for a surgery, illness or injury. The Pathway Rehabilitation Unit offers physical, occupational and speech therapy, as well as discharge planning to help people recover and return home. In addition to being Medicare-certified, the Pathway Unit is a preferred provider of several managed care insurance companies.
