## **Lutheran Social Services of Illinois to Hold Elisabeth von Trapp Christmas Concert**

On Thursday, December 13, Lutheran Social Services of Illinois (LSSI) will hold a concert featuring Elisabeth von Trapp, granddaughter of the legendary Maria and Baron von Trapp whose story inspired *The Sound of Music*. She will be performing at St. John's Lutheran Church, located at 1617 East Emerson in Bloomington, at 7:30 p.m.

Elisabeth von Trapp's earliest memories are the sounds of music. Born and raised in Vermont, she has carried on the legacy of the internationally renowned *Trapp Family Singers*. Singing professionally since childhood, Elisabeth has performed all over the world, enchanting audiences in a variety of venues from European cathedrals to the John F. Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts in Washington, D.C.

Building on her family's legacy, Elisabeth has created her own musical style, at once ethereal and earthy, delicate and powerful. Listeners have likened her to Judy Collins and Loreena McKennitt. Critics have called her voice "hauntingly clear," "joyfully expressive" and "simply beautiful."
