## Hygiene Kits for Returning Citizens

Through its Prisoner and Family Ministry (PFM), Lutheran Social Services of Illinois (LSSI) provides reentry services to men and women who have left prison and are returning to the community. Through its Reentry Services and Connections programs, LSSI links these “returning citizens” to community resources, such as food pantries, job-training programs and substance abuse treatment. Many of these individuals have no homes to return to and must live in shelters. As a result, they have a special need for personal care products, which are not supplied by shelters. Prisoner and Family Ministry provides reentry services in Chicago, Marion, Rockford and East Saint Louis.

### Hygiene Kits are needed for men and women served in our Reentry Services and Connections Programs.

Adult soft toothbrush
Toothpaste 6 ounces
Deodorant 2.6 ounces
Shampoo 15 ounces
Shaving Cream
Disposable razor
Soap/Wet wipes
10 band-aids
Wide tooth comb
Hand sanitizer
Tampons, 18 count
Panty liners, 22 count
Lotion 2.5 ounces

Man’s Hygiene Kit
Adult soft toothbrush
Toothpaste 6 ounces
Deodorant 2.6 ounces
Shampoo 15 ounces
Shaving Cream
Disposable razor
Soap/Wet wipes
10 band-aids
Comb and/or brush
Hand sanitizer
Lotion 2.5 ounces
