Any elderly or disabled person who is 18 and older and who requires the design features of our accessible units.

How big are the apartments?

All apartments are one-bedroom and approximately 550 square feet. Each has a kitchenette and a bathroom with grab rails.

How much is the rent?

As of May 1, 2016, rent is \$572 per month with additional subsidies for those who qualify.

Does your facility offer meals?

Residents have the choice of cooking in their apartment, purchasing meals in our dining room (\$6 for dinner and \$5 for supper), Meals on Wheels and snacks at our Country Store.

What if I have a medical emergency?

All apartments include a free subscription to LifeLine, an emergency alert system which includes a pendant you can use to summon help. We encourage all tenants to wear the pendant in the apartment.

What amenities does Joshua Arms offer?

Our Country Store provides snack items and staple items for sale five days a week. We offer a beauty shop, full service dining room, and a laundry room.
